Whyalla Baptist Youth Ministry

There are certain behaviours which will not be tolerated at Youth under any circumstances. These include but are not limited to:

- Leaving the property/venue of the activity
- Verbal abuse towards any other person will not be tolerated. This includes verbal abuse towards leaders, helpers and peers.
- Alcohol, drugs (of any kind), smoking
- Physical, sexual or inappropriate contact between any two or more individuals.
- Physical violence towards others or property
- Swearing or bad language will not be tolerated as there is a vast age range between the oldest and youngest members of the group.
- Vandalism
- Stealing
- Ongoing harassment or bullying
- Continued disobedience - refusing to obey the instruction of leaders.

Youth group members who engage in misbehaviour as listed above or deemed inappropriate by leaders or helpers will be removed from the group and sent home immediately. Parents will be contacted, and if necessary Police may be involved.

The young person's re-involvement in the group will continue after an exclusion period of ONE week, but will be based upon their own confession of guilt apology to leaders and persons involved and a change in their behaviour. Ongoing bad behaviour will not be tolerated and young people will be taught about consequences to their actions.

All youth leaders work under the banner of Whyalla Baptist Church and in accordance with the outlines of the Baptist Union of South Australia. Leaders and helpers will comply with all applicable legislation, will have current police checks conducted. Mandatory Reporting will be carried out as per our legal obligations under Child Protection Legislation. At all times the safety and security of all young people is our paramount concern.

At NO time will young people be transported in vehicles driven by Provisional Licence holders.

Good behaviour will be expected as part of participation and involvement in the group.
